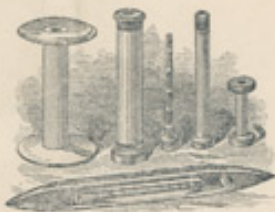

Lynchburg sent to about \$1400.00. The Shuttle
Combination never amounted to a row of pins
could not get all the factories to acquiesce

getting up by the Combination but don't
think a Shuttle has been sold by it - at
all. no news of special note except - Cotton
factory fever raging in town again Cooperative
factory has been organized and will be
built right away I learn. Farmers Alliance
